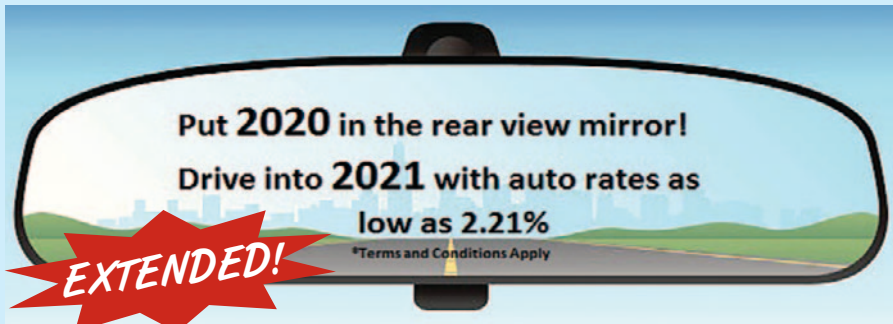

HOW TO TRAVEL SAFELY DURING COVID-19

Travel can increase your risk of exposure to COVID-19, but don't let the coronavirus ruin your getaway. Take these steps before you leave to minimize your risk during vacation.

Check coronavirus trends. Find out if coronavirus infections are spreading both where you're traveling from and at your destination. This can help you decide what risk you may pose to others and the risk they may pose to you.

Research coronavirus restrictions. See if the city, county, or state where you're going has any restrictions on visitors. In addition to smart practices like social distancing and wearing a mask or other face covering, some places require visitors from COVID-19 hotspots to self-isolate for up to 14 days.

Stock up on essentials. Make sure you have plenty of hand sanitizer and face masks. We recommend carrying a ziplock or other reusable bag where you can easily store and retrieve face coverings, sanitizing wipes, and hand sanitizer.

SAFETY TIPS FOR AIR TRAVEL

Watch your bags. You need to keep a close eye on your luggage at all times, even once you board the plane.

Protect your laptop. When going through security, put your laptop on the x-ray belt last.

Sanitize. Carry hand sanitizer or disinfecting wipes to wipe down your hands, bags, laptop, and phone after going through security.

Wash your hands. After you've wiped everything down, stop at the nearest bathroom to wash with soap and water.

When you get to your seat, wipe down the seat, the safety belt buckle, the tray, and anything else that gets touched (especially if you're traveling with little ones).

Store your carry-on nearby. On the airplane, if you don't put your luggage under the seat in front of you, put it in the overhead bin across the aisle from you.
